




Q2 How easy is it to get through to someone at the practice on the phone?





Q3 How easy is it to speak to a doctor or nurse on the phone?





Q4 If you need to see a doctor urgently, can you normally get to see or speak to a GP on the same day?





Q5 How do you normally book your appointments?





Q6 Please rank your preferred method for booking appointments at the practice?





Q7 Thinking of times when you want to see a particular doctor, how quickly do you usually get seen?





Q8 Thinking of times when you want to see a particular doctor, how do you rate how quickly you were seen?





Q9 Thinking of times when you are willing to see any doctor, how quickly do you usually get seen?





Q10 Thinking of times when you are willing to see any doctor, how do you rate how quickly you were seen?





Q11 Thinking of your most recent consultation with a doctor or nurse here at the Health Centre, how long (after your appointment time) did you wait for your consultation to start?







Q13 Is the practice currently open at times that are convenient to you?







Q15 Is there a particular GP you usually prefer to see or speak to?





Q16 How often are you able to see or speak to the GP you prefer?









Q19 How likely are you to recommend your GP surgery to friends and family if they need similar care or treatment?





Q20 Within the last 6 months have you seen a GP for a face to face consultation?







Q22 Do you feel that the GP listened to what you had to say and involved you in the decisions which were made?





Q23 Did you feel that a face to face appointment was appropriate for the problem or could this have been dealt with by telephone?





Q24 After the consultation did the GP leave you with sufficient information about what would happen next in terms of managing or treating your problem?





Q25 Within the last 6 months have you had a telephone consultation with a GP?





Q26 Thinking about your last telephone consultation with a GP, was this a GP triage call (an urgent problem which needed assessment on the same day)?















Q32 Within the last 6 months has a GP visited you at home for a consultation?













Q39 Are you Male or female?








